

ORDINANCE 269-A (AMENDING 269)

AN ORDINANCE **AMENDING** ORDINANCE NO 269 OF THE CITY OF MCCRORY, ARKANSAS ADOPTED JUNE 11, 2001 TO REGULATE KEEPING LIVESTOCK OR FOWL IN CITY LIMITS OF MCCRORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCCRORY, ARKANSAS:

**SECTION 1:** It shall be, and hereby declared to be, unlawful for person, firm or corporation to keep any livestock (cattle, horses, mules, swine, sheep, goats or any other animals of like kind) or fowl ( no more than six(6) allowed in a completely contained encloser, chicken, guinea, duck, or goose) within (200) two hundred yards of any house or place of residence occupied by any other person, or any place of residence occupied by any other person or any place of business selling or handling for sale any food or beverage for human consumption, without the prior written approval of the Mayor of said city of McCrory, Arkansas.

**SECTION 2:** Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fines in any sum not less than Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00), no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and each day such condition or offense is allowed to continue after due notice from authorized officer or officers of the said city of McCrory, of such offense, shall constitute a separate offense. Any person, firm, or corporation has 30 days from the date of first notification by officer to abide by said Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** It is hereby ascertained that it is necessary for the health, safety and public welfare of the citizens of the City of McCrory, Arkansas, to prohibit any person, firm or corporation to keep any livestock or fowl except as stated above within the city of McCrory as set forth herein. It is, therefore, declared that any emergency exists and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of said city, said ordinance shall take effect and be in force from immediately after its passage.
